Be it remembered, that Perry Nicholas Lucius then residing at number 757 Street, Town of Mouriava, State Territory of Kansas, who previous to his naturalization was a subject of Charlotte W. Lucius of Freeburg, having applied to be admitted a citizen of the United States of America pursuant to law, and at a Regular Term of the District Court of Atchison County, held at Atchison, on the 17th day of September, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and 25, the court having found that the petitioner had resided continuously within the United States for at least five years and in this State for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the filing of his petition, and that said petitioner intends to reside permanently in the United States, had in all respects complied with the law in relation thereto, and that he was entitled to be so admitted, it was thereupon ordered by the said court that he be admitted as a citizen of the United States of America.

In testimony whereof the seal of said court is hereunto affixed on the 19 day of September in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and 25, and of our Independence the one hundred and 49
