



Land Holdings Around Mt. Pleasant

- The following three slides present **Plat Maps** of the townships of Mt. Pleasant and Walnut in Atchison County, Kansas for the following years: 1896, 1903, 1925
- On these maps I have colored all lands owned at that time by Luxembourers or descendants of Luxembourgers.

Note several trends:

- Original parcels of land tend to be passed down through families over time
- There is a general diffusion of land holdings by Luxembourgers away from the original settlement area

·Aeriel Photo of John Lucius's Original Land in Mt. Pleasant






